This Fund Raising event, to support Research into the prevention of Cancer in Children is to be held in the tidal reaches of the River Wyre and starts at the historic port of Fleetwood

"SEAQUEST" 22 kms, a testing and challenging event, starts on the beach "Le Mans style", at the Marine Hall Fleetwood. Using a map of the course, it involves locating checkpoints, exiting kayaks, punching route cards, and runs up-stream to Shard Bridge with the flooding tide, takes in the benefits of slack water and then uses the ebb to return to the finish. Competitors will need to be fit to cover the 22 kms, have map reading skills and must be competent at rescues should a capsized occur.

"SEATOUR" slightly shorter at 15 km, but with similar challenges, also locates checkpoints, punches route cards and turns at Stanah.

The Wyre estuary offers many interesting aspects and challenges to paddlers, observing the wildlife, using navigational skills to locate the checkpoints, reading the water and the flow of the tide. Local experts will be on hand on the day to give advice. Winds and currents can be VERY strong.

You may compete as an individual, a team of 3 craft or Tandem Canoe. Trophies will be awarded at the BBQ held at the Clubhouse following the event. All paddlers completing the course will receive a certificate showing their time.

Juniors under 18 must be entered and accompanied on the course by a competent Adult.

Entry fees will be donated to the charity "Leukaemia-Busters"
